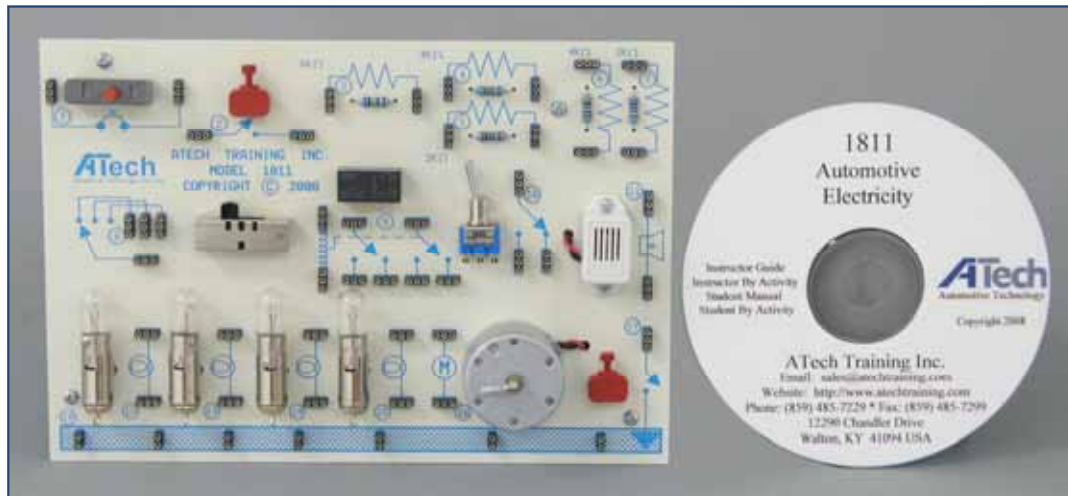


AUTOMOTIVE ELECTRICITY COURSEBOARD MODEL 1811
